## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Five.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF FISHERIES AND GAME TO CONVEY CERTAIN LAND IN THE TOWN OF BOXFORD TO THE COUNTY OF ESSEX.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The director of the division of fisheries and game, in the  
2 name and on behalf of the commonwealth, is hereby authorized  
3 and directed, subject to the approval of the governor, to con-  
4 vey for a consideration of one dollar to the inhabitants of the  
5 county of Essex, by a deed, approved as to form by the attorney  
6 general, all the right, title and interest of the commonwealth  
7 in and to two parcels of land situated in the town of Boxford,  
8 for highway purposes. Said parcels are bounded and described  
9 as follows: —

10 Parcel #1. A parcel of land located on the southwesterly  
11 side of Middleton Road and bounded northeasterly by said  
12 Middleton Road as defined by a stone wall, about 195 feet  
13 and southwesterly by the proposed southwesterly line of the  
14 highway about 190 feet, said parcel containing about 175  
15 square feet.

16 Parcel #2. A parcel of land located on the southwesterly side  
17 of said Middleton Road and bounded northeasterly by said  
18 Middleton Road as defined by a stone wall, about 307 feet  
19 and southwesterly by the proposed southwesterly line of the  
20 highway about 295 feet, said parcel containing about 5280  
21 square feet.

22 Said parcels are shown on a plan entitled "Plan of a Portion  
 23 of Middleton Road in the Town of Boxford, Earl H. Page,  
 24 County Engineer, Scale 1" equals 40'" and dated May 12, 1964  
 25 and filed in the office of the county engineer at Salem.
