

Bill accompanying the petition of Edwin O. Childs, mayor of the city of Newton, that cities and towns be authorized to limit buildings according to their use or construction. Mercantile Affairs. January 21.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty.

AN ACT

To authorize Cities and Towns to limit Buildings according to their Use or Construction.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. A city or town may by ordinance or by-
2 law, not inconsistent with law, limit buildings used for
3 manufacturing, industrial or mercantile purposes to
4 certain specified districts.

1 SECTION 2. A city or town may by ordinance or by-
2 law, not inconsistent with law, limit buildings used for
3 purposes of habitation by more than two families to
4 certain specified districts.

1 SECTION 3. A city or town may by ordinance or by-
2 law, not inconsistent with law, limit buildings which are
3 of non-fireproof construction to certain specified districts.
