RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING A HISTORY OF A TITLE RECORD OF REAL PROPERTY TO PRECLUDE THE NECESSITY OF REPEATED TITLE EXAMINATIONS.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of repre-
3 sentatives, and two persons to be appointed by the governor,
4 is hereby established for the purpose of making an investiga-
5 tion and study relative to establishing a system of permanent
6 history of real property title records for individual parcels in
7 order to preclude the necessity of repeated title examinations.
