

HOUSE No. 726.

[Bill accompanying the petition of George McAleer and others. Fisheries and Game.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-six.

AN ACT

To prevent Fishing through the Ice on the Northerly End of Lake Quinsigamond in Worcester or Shrewsbury.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Whoever takes from the water of that part of Quinsi-
2 gamond lake in Worcester or Shrewsbury, northerly of
3 the turnpike bridge, which is crossed on the old road
4 passing by the city farm to Shrewsbury, any fish by
5 fishing through the ice at any time until November first,
6 nineteen hundred and one, shall forfeit one dollar for
7 each fish so taken; and in any prosecutions under this
8 act the possession of any fish on the ice on said premises
9 shall be prima facie evidence of a violation thereof.
