
such examination is a condition of the particular investment, lending, loan guaranty or grant program administered by such corporation.

SECTION 6. Chapter 324 of the acts of 1987 is hereby amended by striking out section 8 and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

Section 8. Section six of this act shall take effect on July first, two thousand.

Chapter 529. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE STILES LAKE WATER DISTRICT TO CORRECT CERTAIN TAX BILLS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of any law or regulation to the contrary, the commissioners of the Stiles Lake Water District are hereby authorized to correct all fiscal nineteen hundred and ninety tax assessments erroneously made on the basis of nineteen hundred and eighty-nine property values and adjust the taxpayers' bills based on their nineteen hundred and eighty-eight property values.

Chapter 530. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TRUSTEES OF THE MILTON CEMETERY IN THE TOWN OF MILTON TO BORROW CERTAIN FUNDS FOR CEMETERY DEVELOPMENT PURPOSES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter one hundred and fourteen of the General Laws, or any other general or special law to the contrary, the trustees of the Milton cemetery may, from time to time, for the purpose of capital expenditures for cemetery development, borrow from the cemetery perpetual care fund heretofore established, up to one-third of the market value of such fund.

SECTION 2. Each such borrowing and the terms of such borrowing, including without limitation, the rate of interest, shall be authorized by a two-thirds vote of the town meeting. In no event shall the term of such borrowing be in excess of ten years. The principal and interest of notes or bonds issued hereunder shall be paid from the proceeds of the sale of burial rights in such manner as the said trustees of said cemetery may determine, with the approval of the board of selectmen, but in no case may any portion of such payment be effected by appropriation from the
