AN ACT RELATIVE TO PRESCRIPTION ADVANTAGE, SO-CALLED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or specific law to the contrary, members of prescription advantage, so-called, may
- 2 obtain 3 months supply of prescriptions from pharmacies.
