

Chap. 110. AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE VENUE FOR COMPLAINTS FOR FAILURE TO PAY CONTRIBUTIONS TO HEALTH, WELFARE OR RETIREMENT TRUST FUNDS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 10 of chapter 151D of the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 326 of the acts of 1968, is hereby further amended by adding the following paragraph: —

A complaint under this section may be brought in the municipal court of the city of Boston, or in a district court within the territorial jurisdiction of which the employer has his principal place of business, or within which the contributions are to be paid, or, if said complaint is brought against an officer of a corporation, within which said officer lives.

Chap. 111. AN ACT AUTHORIZING A NIECE, NEPHEW, AUNT OR UNCLE TO ADMINISTER CERTAIN ESTATES NOT EXCEEDING ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS IN VALUE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The first paragraph of section 16 of chapter 195 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 325 of the acts of 1966, is hereby further amended by striking out, in lines 3 and 4, the words "or sister" and inserting in place thereof the words: — , sister, niece, nephew, aunt or uncle.

Chap. 112. AN ACT CHANGING THE TITLE OF THE "CIVIL DEFENSE AGENCY" TO THE "CIVIL DEFENSE AGENCY AND OFFICE OF EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS".

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 2 of chapter 639 of the acts of 1950 is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — There is hereby created within the executive branch of the commonwealth a division of civil defense to be known as the "civil defense agency and office of emergency preparedness" hereinafter called the "civil defense agency", which shall be under the direction of a director of civil defense hereinafter called the "director".

Chap. 113. AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE THE THIRTIETH, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY, TO PROVIDE FOR SUPPLEMENTING CERTAIN EXISTING APPROPRIATIONS AND FOR CERTAIN NEW ACTIVITIES AND PROJECTS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. To provide for supplementing certain items in the general appropriation act and for certain new activities and projects, the sums set forth in section two of this act are hereby appropriated

from the General Fund unless specifically designated otherwise in the item, subject to the provisions of law regulating the disbursement of public funds and the conditions pertaining to appropriations in chapter four hundred and fifty-two of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-nine for the fiscal year ending June the thirtieth, nineteen hundred and seventy, or for such period as may be specified, the sums so appropriated to be in addition to any amounts at present available for the purposes.

Chap. 114. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF WORCESTER TO MAKE CERTAIN EXPENDITURES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE COUNTY APPROPRIATION ACT FOR THE CURRENT YEAR TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE WORCESTER JUVENILE COURT.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provisions of section thirty-four of chapter thirty-five of the General Laws, the county treasurer of the county of Worcester may, on and after January the first in the current year, expend from any money on hand such sums as may be necessary to continue the operation of the Worcester Juvenile Court, established by chapter eight hundred and fifty-nine of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-nine; provided that personal services and other expenses shall be limited to those positions and other expenses approved in accordance with the provisions of section thirty-six A of said chapter thirty-five; and any money so expended shall be included in the estimates of expenditures submitted to the general court in anticipation of the county appropriation act for the current year.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of January the first in the current year.
