AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Maintenance of the
Lyman School for Boys.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding one hundred
2 twenty-three thousand two hundred dollars is hereby
3 appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the
4 commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for the
5 maintenance of the Lyman school for boys, for the
6 fiscal year ending on the thirtieth day of November,
7 nineteen hundred and fourteen. (Rev. Laws, ch. 86.)

(Appropriation 1913, \$114,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
