To accompany the petition of Andrew P. Quigley, Harry Coltun and another that provision be made for temporary absorption by the Metropolitan District Commission for a recreational park of approximately three acres of land of the Soldiers' Home property in Chelsea. Metropolitan Affairs.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR TEMPORARY ABSORPTION BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION FOR A RECREATIONAL PARK OF APPROXIMATELY THREE ACRES OF LAND OF THE WESTERLY END OF THE SOLDIERS' HOME PROPERTY, CHELSEA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The trustees of the Soldiers' Home, Chelsea, hereby
2 request that the metropolitan district commission as-
3 sume the obligation of maintaining for recreational
4 purposes the vacant lot at the westerly end of the
5 junction of Summit avenue and LaFayette avenue,
6 Chelsea, approximately three acres, formerly known
7 as Malone park; same to be established as a park with
8 recreational facilities until such time as the Soldiers'
9 Home is prepared in the future to develop the prop-
10 erty in the expansion of existing buildings and to be
11 maintained by the metropolitan district commission.
