AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DEFINITION OF "CODE" UNDER THE STATE TAX ADMINISTRATIVE CHAPTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 62C of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 section 22 of chapter 415 of the acts of 1976, is hereby amended by
3 striking out the definition of "Code", and inserting in place thereof
4 the following definition: —
