**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES TO GRANT AN EASEMENT ON CERTAIN LAND IN THE TOWN OF DOUGLAS TO THE COUNTY OF WORCESTER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The Department of Natural Resources, acting for and in behalf  
2 of the Commonwealth is hereby authorized to grant to Worcester  
3 County an easement for highway purposes in a strip of land 66  
4 feet in width, known as Southwest Main Street in the Town of  
5 Douglas. Said easement is delineated on a plan entitled, "plan of  
6 Southwest Main Street in the Town of Douglas proposed  
7 highway easements from Commonwealth of Massachusetts  
8 Department of Natural Resources", dated April 2, 1975 and  
9 recorded in the Worcester District Registry of Deeds, Plan Book  
10 No. 409, Plan No. 110.

11 The Department of Natural Resources is further authorized to  
12 grant to Worcester County an easement for the purpose of  
13 extending slopes beyond the limits of the above described area  
14 and an easement to install such drainage structures as may be  
15 required.
