By Mr. Semensi of Randolph, petition of Joseph J. Semensi and other members of the General Court relative to making permanent certain temporary inspectors of the Registry of Motor Vehicles under the civil service law and rules. Public service.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN POSITIONS IN THE REGISTRY OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, all  
2 persons who were certified on a civil service list that was  
3 established March twenty-six, nineteen hundred and sixty-  
4 six and who were appointed prior to March twenty-fifth,  
5 nineteen hundred and sixty-eight as temporary inspectors  
6 in the registry of motor vehicles shall be deemed to be per-  
7 manently appointed notwithstanding the fact that said list  
8 has since expired.
