AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE INSURANCE ADVISORY COMMITTEES OF CERTAIN CITIES AND TOWNS, COUNTIES AND DISTRICTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 3 of chapter 32B of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence, as
3 most recently amended by chapter 183 of the acts of 1975, and
4 inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — Prior to the
5 purchase of said insurance, and execution of all such agreements or
6 contracts within the limits established by said sections, the
7 appropriate public authority shall consult with an advisory
8 committee consisting of representatives from each employee
9 organization affected, for the purpose of securing the written
10 recommendations of a majority of the membership of said
11 committee.
