AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN STRUCTURAL ALTERATIONS AT THE ARMORY IN THE TOWN OF HINGHAM

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The armory commission is hereby au-  
2 thorized to make such structural alterations at the  
3 armory in the town of Hingham as may be necessary  
4 to make the entrance and exit facilities thereat con-  
5 form to requirements of the laws relating to the safety  
6 of persons in places of public assembly, and thereby  
7 increase the seating capacity. For said purposes,  
8 said commission may expend not exceeding one thou-  
9 sand dollars upon the payment of said sum into the  
10 state treasury by said town of Hingham. Any  
11 balance of said sum remaining after the completion  
12 of the alterations shall be repaid to said town.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
