SENATE No. 1037

By Mr. Locke, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1037) of David H. Locke for legislation to authorize the issuance of ambulance plates for motor vehicles registered to recognized nonprofit organizations and used exclusively for the emergency transportation of human organs. Public Safety.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF AMBULANCE PLATES FOR MOTOR VEHICLES REGISTERED TO RECOGNIZED NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS AND USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR THE EMERGENCY TRANSPORTATION OF HUMAN ORGANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out the definition "Ambulance" and inserting in place
3 thereof the following definition: —
4 "Ambulance", a motor vehicle equipped and used exclusively
5 for the transportation of sick, injured or wounded persons, or a
6 motor vehicle registered to a recognized nonprofit organization
7 and used exclusively for the emergency transportation of human
8 organs, or a motor vehicle operated by a society incorporated
9 under the laws of the commonwealth for the prevention of cruelty
10 to animals, or for the care and protection of harmless or suffering
11 animals, and used exclusively for the transportation of stray and
12 neglected, sick, injured, or wounded animals.
