SENATE, January 5, 1989.

1 *Ordered*, That the Rules of the Senate be amended in Rule 31
2 by inserting after the sentence, "The proposed amendment shall
3 be printed in the Calendar and the Journal." the following new
4 sentences: —

5 The President shall then announce to the members that, absent
6 a further request under this rule, the matter shall be placed in the
7 Orders of the next day after that on which the amendment is made.
8 Thereupon, at the request of three members, the matter shall not
9 be placed in the Orders of the next day, but in place of printing
10 the proposed amendment in the Calendar and the Journal, the
11 President shall immediately declare a recess until such time as the
12 Clerk can distribute a copy of the amendment to the desk of each
13 member, and the amendment shall be considered forthwith.
