RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF JAMES J. McCORMACK.

1 *Resolved*, That for the purpose of discharging a moral
2 obligation of the commonwealth, there be allowed and
3 paid out of the state treasury, subject to appropriation,
4 to James J. McCormack the sum of nineteen hundred
5 and seventy-five dollars, the amount of counsel fees ex-
6 pended by said James J. McCormack in his successful
7 action for reinstatement as district superintendent in the
8 Massachusetts department of employment security after
9 his removal therefrom.
