AN ACT REGULATING THE COST OF LIVING INCREASE  
FOR RETIRED TEACHERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special
- 2 law to the contrary the cost of living increase for retired
- 3 teachers on pensions shall be equal to the most recent cost of
- 4 living index.

AN ACT TO ORGANIZE THE COMMISSION ON APPOINTMENTS  
FOR THE PHILIPPINES

- It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Congress assembled, that the authority of the same be defined as follows:
1. The Commission on Appointments shall be composed of seven members, to be appointed by the President of the Philippines.
  2. Two of the members shall be appointed by the President of the Philippines.
  3. The President of the Philippines shall be equal to the other members of the Commission on Appointments.
  4. The Commission on Appointments shall be organized as follows:
