## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CORRECTION OF AN INEQUITY IN THE METHOD OF COLLECTION OF CERTAIN TAXES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section forty  
2 A of chapter one hundred and forty-seven of the General Laws,  
3 any licensee who has paid a tax equal to one per cent on amounts  
4 actually received by him which were subject to taxation under  
5 said section forty A shall be exempt from further taxation under  
6 said section.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply to taxes due under said  
2 section forty A from January first, nineteen hundred and sixty to  
3 its effective date.
