Tracy and Kevin G. Honan for legislation to further regulate the process and the removal of trash from certain apartment houses, the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2065) of the Massachusetts Municipal Association, Robert A. DeLeo and other members of the House relative to the authority of the boards of selectmen of towns to transfer certain previously appropriated funds, and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3247) of Warren E. Tolman relative to the licensing and appointment of arborists in cities and towns, reports recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 4517) ought to be adopted.
