## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Six.

### RESOLVE

To provide for the Furnishing of Medals to Certain Persons who served in the War with Spain.

1 *Resolved*, That the governor appoint a suitable person,  
2 and that the person so appointed, the lieutenant governor  
3 and the adjutant general, be commissioners, without pay,  
4 to cause to be struck off a suitable medal for each officer,  
5 soldier or sailor who served during the war with Spain  
6 and who, at the time of his enlistment, was a legal resi-  
7 dent of Massachusetts, and who was honorably discharged  
8 from or died in the service; and that the adjutant general  
9 deliver such medals, on application, to such persons as  
10 he may deem entitled to receive the same.
