

SENATE No. 91

To accompany the petition of Henry S. Clark relative to the conversion of certain dwelling houses in the city of Boston into three-family apartment houses. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Two.

AN ACT

Authorizing the Conversion of Certain Single and Two-family Dwelling Houses in the City of Boston into Dwelling Houses of the Three-family Type.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 For a period of five years following the passage
2 of this act, any single or two-family dwelling of
3 third-class construction situated in any part of
4 the city of Boston comprised within the present
5 building limits and outside said limits as they
6 existed prior to the twenty-second day of Sep-
7 tember, nineteen hundred and thirteen, may be
8 converted by such changes, alterations or addi-
9 tions as may be necessary into dwellings for the
10 occupation of not more than three families.
