### AN ACT REQUIRING EVENING HOURS OF OPERATION AT REGISTRY OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 9 of chapter 16 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by adding thereof the following paragraph: —
- 3 The registrar shall authorize additional hours of operation for
- 4 the registry offices to ensure that such offices are open until nine
- 5 o'clock post meridiem at least one day a week.
