AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES OF CERTAIN FOREMEN, INSPECTORS, MECHANICS, DRAWTENDERS, ASSISTANT DRAWTENDERS AND STOREKEEPERS FORMERLY EMPLOYED BY THE CITY OF FALL RIVER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The limitation of the amount of the
2 retirement allowances of foremen, inspectors, me-
3 chanics, drawtenders, assistant drawtenders and store-
4 keepers in the city of Fall River, imposed by section
5 one of chapter two hundred and seventy-eight of the
6 acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-four, as amended
7 by section one of chapter seventy-one of the acts of
8 nineteen hundred and thirty, shall not restrict the
9 retirement allowances of such of said employees as
10 were retired by said city thereunder prior to January
11 first, nineteen hundred and thirty-eight.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance during the current year by vote of the
3 city council of said city, subject to the provisions of
4 its charter, but not otherwise.
