The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Five.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO ESTABLISH A TECHNICIAN SECTION AND CO-OPERATIVE PROGRAM WITH COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 16 of the General Laws, as amended by section 1 of
2 chapter 821 of the acts of 1963, is hereby further amended by
3 adding after section 4 the following section: —

4 *Section 4A.* The commissioner may establish the following
5 requirements for applicants taking examinations for the follow-
6 ing positions in the department of public works.

7 For the position of principal engineering aide (J. G. 13) the
8 applicant shall be a permanent senior engineering aide with one
9 year of certified time in that grade and shall have passed a
10 written competitive examination; or shall have completed two
11 years at an accredited college or university of engineering and
12 had one year of full time paid experience in civil engineering
13 field or office work, or a combination of both.

14 For the position of head engineering aide (J. G. 15) the ap-
15 plicant shall be a permanent principal engineering aide, with one
16 year of certified time in that grade and shall have passed a
17 written competitive examination, or shall have completed two
18 years at an accredited college or university of engineering and
19 had two years of full time paid experience in civil engineering
20 field or office work or a suitable combination of both.

21 Notwithstanding any provisions of chapter thirty-one, the
22 commissioner may make intermittent appointments as junior
23 engineering aide trainee or senior engineering aide trainee a

24 person who is enrolled as a regular student in an engineering
25 program at an accredited college or university leading to a
26 bachelor of science degree at an accredited college.

27 These intermittent appointments will be given to students
28 participating in regular co-operative programs at accredited
29 colleges or universities of engineering and/or regular students
30 enrolled in engineering at accredited colleges and universities
31 during summer vacation periods.
