AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO RELINQUISH CARE, CUSTODY AND CONTROL OF A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND IN THE CITY OF LYNN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special
2 law to the contrary, the metropolitan district commission is
3 hereby authorized to relinquish all right, title and interest in a
4 parcel of land under their care, custody and control contain-
5 ing approximately twenty-two thousand five hundred square
6 feet, more or less, bounded by Beach road and Lynn Shore
7 drive in said city and under the control of said commission in
8 the city of Lynn and shown on a plan herein included, to the
9 city of Lynn. Said city is hereby authorized, by a majority
10 vote of the city council, to convey said parcel to Broad Street
11 Trust, Saul Gilberg, Trustee, 89 Lewis Street, Lynn, MA 01902
12 for the purpose of constructing a parking facility. When said
13 land ceases to be used as a parking facility it shall revert to
14 the city of Lynn.
