**AN ACT TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURES TO PROVIDE FOR REGULAR CONSULTATIONS BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE AND THE FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION.**
