AN ACT REGULATING THE TOWING OF MOTOR VEHICLES FROM PRIVATE PROPERTY OR PROPERTY TO WHICH THE PUBLIC HAS ACCESS AND IS INVITED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 159B of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 6D the following section: —

3 *Section 6E.* Any person or corporation licensed to tow
4 motor vehicles by the department of public utilities shall,
5 before towing a motor vehicle from private property, notify
6 the police department of the city or town in which the vehicle
7 to be towed is situated, giving a complete description of said
8 vehicle and the place to which such vehicle is to be towed.
