AN ACT REQUIRING COURSES RELATIVE TO LAWS AND LEGAL
PROCESSES BE OFFERED TO CERTAIN SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by chapter 282 of the acts of 1952, is hereby
3 further amended by adding the following sentence: — In all
4 public junior high schools a course relative to the content, and
5 character of laws generally applicable to young adults, conse-
6 quences of violations of said laws and the basic legal processes
7 of the police departments and courts of the commonwealth,
8 shall be offered and open to those students who wish to elect
9 it.
