The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

An Act providing for an Increase in the Compensation paid to Members of the State Police.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section nine A of chapter twenty-two
2 of the General Laws, as appearing in the Tercente-
3 nary edition, is hereby amended by adding at the
4 end thereof the following:—

5 The compensation paid to members of the state
6 police appointed under this section shall be as follows:—

	Minimum	Maximum
7 Patrolmen	\$1,500	\$1,800
8 Corporals	1,800	2,100
9 Sergeants	2,100	2,400
10 Lieutenants	2,400	2,700

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of January
2 first of the current year.

Resolved, That the Commission of the General Land Office be and they are authorized to make such regulations as may be necessary to carry into effect the provisions of the Act approved March 3, 1879, relating to the disposal of the public lands.
