**AN ACT** DIRECTING THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION IN MEDICINE TO GRANT A CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION TO PRACTICE MEDICINE TO ALAIN B. ROSSIER.

1     *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to  
2 defeat its purpose, which is to grant forthwith a certificate of  
3 registration to practice medicine to Alain B. Rossier, therefore it  
4 is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the  
5 immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1             Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law or of any  
2 rule or regulation of the board of registration as a qualified  
3 physician to practice medicine within the Commonwealth to  
4 Alain B. Rossier for a period of five years inclusive from the  
5 effective date of this act and if within said five-year period, the  
6 said Alain B. Rossier becomes a permanent resident of the  
7 commonwealth and evidences his intention to become a citizen  
8 of the United States to the board, said board shall grant a  
9 certificate of registration to practice medicine within the  
10 commonwealth to the said Alain B. Rossier without limitation as  
11 to time.
