

By Messrs. Weinberg of Boston and Lane of Boston, petition of Norman S. Weinberg and Edmund V. Lane relative to the parking of motor vehicles on streets and ways in the city of Boston. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON STREETS AND WAYS IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The last paragraph of section 2 of chapter 263 of
2 the acts of 1929, added by section 1 of chapter 366
3 of the acts of 1952, is hereby amended by inserting
4 after the word "it", in line 5, the words:— shall not
5 apply to such streets and ways as shall be prescribed
6 in such rule or regulation, and it, — so as to read as
7 follows:— Any rule or regulation, adopted under this
8 section, prohibiting the parking or standing of vehicles
9 on the whole or any part or parts of one or more
10 streets, ways, highways, roads or parkways, under
11 the control of the city, may provide that it shall not
12 apply to such streets and ways as shall be prescribed
13 in such rule or regulation, and it shall not apply at
14 such times as shall be prescribed in such rule or
15 regulation to any motor vehicle registered under
16 chapter ninety of the General Laws and owned or
17 used by a person residing on an estate abutting in
18 whole or in part the portion of the street, way, high-
19 way, road or parkway where such vehicle is parked,
20 who, in the year in which such vehicle is parked or

21 in the preceding December for such year, shall have
22 given, by a writing executed in such form and detail
23 as such rule or regulation shall prescribe and filed
24 with the officer in command of the police division in
25 which such vehicle is parked, notice of intention to
26 park at such estate and shall display in a conspicuous
27 place on such vehicle, while parked, such visible evi-
28 dence of the giving of such notice as such rule or
29 regulation shall prescribe; but neither the giving of
30 such notice nor the issuance of visible evidence of the
31 giving thereof shall be construed to assign any specific
32 space to any person or vehicle.
