By Mr. Scibelli of Springfield, petition of Frank H. Freedman (mayor), Anthony M. Scibelli, Arthur J. McKenna, James J. Bowler, Alan D. Sisitsky, Rudy Chmura and James L. Grimaldi (with the approval of the mayor and city council) that the city of Springfield be authorized to convey certain park land to the Department of Natural Resources. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD TO CONVEY CERTAIN PARK LAND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The City of Springfield is hereby authorized to
2 transfer and convey to the Department of Natural Resources of
3 the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, for no monetary con-
4 sideration, a parcel of land now owned and held by said City
5 under the control of the parks department, bounded and des-
6 cribed as follows: —

7 Beginning at a point at the southwest corner of land herein
8 described and said point being a point of curve on the easterly
9 side of Blunt Park Road, N. 12° 20' 00" W., a distance of
10 approximately two hundred thirty feet (230'±) northwesterly
11 of the northerly street line of Roosevelt Avenue;

12 Thence; northwesterly along a curve to the left whose radius
13 is two hundred and forty feet (240.00') and whose central
14 angle is 35° 00' 00", an arc distance of one hundred forty-six
15 and sixty one-hundredths feet (146.61') to a point of tangency,
16 Thence; continuing along said easterly side of Blunt Park
17 Road, N. 47° 20' 00", an arc distance of one hundred and
18 sixty-five feet (165.0'), to a point,

- 19 Thence; through park land, N. 42° 40' 00" E., a distance of
20 two hundred seventy five feet (275.00') to a point,
21 Thence; through park land, S. 47° 20' 00" E., a distance of
22 three hundred and seventy feet (370.00') to a point,
23 Thence; through park land, S. 42° 40' 00" W., a distance of
24 one hundred and sixty feet (160.00') to a point,
25 Thence; through park land, S. 65° 42' 00" W., a distance of
26 one hundred seventy-two and twelve hundredths feet
27 (172.12'), to the point of beginning.
28 Said parcel containing 101,252 square feet or 3.2 acres.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
