RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE FEASIBILITY OF REQUIRING THE INSTALLATION OF VOTING MACHINES IN ALL THE VOTING PRECINCTS IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of
2 two members of the senate, three members of the house of repre-
3 sentatives, and two persons to be appointed by the governor,
4 is hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation
5 and study relative to the feasibility of requiring the installation
6 of voting machines in all the voting precincts in the com-
7 monwealth.
