AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE LINCOLN-SUDBURY REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT TO BORROW MONEY FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or
2 special law to the contrary, the Lincoln-Sudbury Regional School
3 District is hereby authorized to borrow money for a term not to
4 exceed ten years for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing
5 and making improvements to outdoor playground, athletic and
6 recreational facilities and for the further purpose of constructing,
7 reconstructing and resurfacing roadways and parking lots at the
8 Lincoln-Sudbury Regional high school. Any debt incurred pursu-
9 ant to the provisions of this act shall, except as provided herein, be
10 subject to the provisions of chapter forty-four and chapter seventy-
11 one of the General Laws to the extent that such chapters may be
12 applicable.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
