AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE DESIGNATION OF CHIEF COURT OFFICER OF PROBATE COURTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 217 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after section 30 the following section: —

3 *Section 30A.* The senior judge of probate for the counties of
4 Suffolk, Middlesex, Plymouth and Norfolk may designate one of
5 the officers appointed pursuant to section thirty to act as a chief
6 court officer. Such officer, in addition to his regular duties as a
7 court officer, shall perform such other duties as from time to time
8 may be prescribed by the senior judge.
