

By Mr. Condon of Boston, petition of John E. Powers and James F. Condon that the Metropolitan District Commission be authorized to acquire certain public bathing beaches and other property in the city of Boston. Metropolitan Affairs.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO ACQUIRE CERTAIN PUBLIC BATHING BEACHES AND OTHER PROPERTY IN BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The metropolitan district commission, on behalf of
2 the commonwealth, is hereby authorized and directed
3 to take by eminent domain under chapter seventy-
4 nine of the General Laws, or acquire by purchase or
5 otherwise, as a part of the system of metropolitan
6 parks under the control of said commission, a tract
7 of land, bordering on Dorchester bay in that part of
8 Boston known as South Boston, from a point com-
9 monly known as the Cow Pasture and extending to
10 the government property on Pleasure bay including
11 in this area beaches known as Carson beach, M Street
12 beach, City Point beach, Farragut beach, the Strand-
13 way district, Farragut road, Columbus park, Marine
14 park, the Aquarium at City Point, the Columbus
15 park, Marine park and L Street bath houses and all
16 other buildings and facilities within the area.
