AN ACT RELATIVE TO UNIFORMS WORN BY SPECIAL POLICE OFFICERS
IN CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 No special police officers licensed by the commissioner of public
- 2 safety, police commissioner or chief of police of any city or town
- 3 shall wear a uniform similar to that worn by the police officers
- 4 in the city or town in which said special officers are working.
