AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ELECTION OF CERTAIN TOWN OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 41, section 1, of the General Laws, as most
- 2 recently amended, is hereby further amended by in-
- 3 serting therein, after the first paragraph, the follow-
- 4 ing:—
- 5 Three trustees of the Public Library for the term of
- 6 three years.
- 7 A town counsel for the term of one year.
- 8 Five registrars of voters for the term of three years;
- 9 not more than three of whom shall, at any one time,
- 10 be members of the same political party.
