Resolve accompanying the petition of Waldo H. Peirce for legislation to reimburse the town of Prescott for money expended for the support of two paupers who should have been state charges. Public Charitable Institutions. January 22.

RESOLVE

To provide for reimbursing the Town of Prescott for Money paid for the Support of Certain Paupers.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the commonwealth to the town of Prescott the
3 sum of nine hundred and sixty-seven dollars and thirty-
4 three cents paid by the town for the support of Nathan M.
5 Horr; and the sum of five hundred and twenty-five dol-
6 lars and forty-one cents paid by the town for the support
7 of Pierce Horr, they having no known settlement in the
8 said town, and these sums having been paid by the town
9 under a misapprehension of facts.
