AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN JUDGES, RECORDERS AND DEPUTY RECORDERS, REGISTERS AND ASSISTANT REGISTERS, AND CLERKS AND ASSISTANT CLERKS OF THE DISTRICT COURTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section
2 sixteen of chapter five hundred and fifty-eight of the acts of
3 nineteen hundred and seventy-four, any judge or associate judge
4 of the land court who was appointed between the first day of
5 January, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, and the effective
6 date of the act shall receive such salary as is provided by section
7 fourteen or chapter one hundred and eighty-five of the General
8 Laws, said salary to be effective as of the date of his appointment.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section
2 sixteen of chapter five hundred and fifty-eight of the acts of
3 nineteen hundred and seventy-four, the justices of the superior
4 court who were appointed between the first day of January,
5 nineteen hundred and seventy-four, and the effective date of this
6 act shall receive such salary as is provided by section twenty-
7 seven of chapter two hundred and twelve of the General Laws,
8 said salary to be effective as of the date of their appointment.

1 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section
2 sixteen of chapter five hundred and fifty-eight of the acts of
3 nineteen hundred and seventy-four, the judges of the probate
4 court who were appointed between the first day of January,
5 nineteen hundred and seventy-four, and the effective date of this
6 act shall receive such salary as is provided by section thirty-four
7 of chapter two hundred and seventeen of the General Laws, said
8 salary to be effective as of the date of their appointment.

1 SECTION 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section
2 sixteen of chapter five hundred and fifty-eight of the acts of
3 nineteen hundred and seventy-four, any special justice of a
4 district court or of the Boston municipal court who was
5 appointed between the first day of January, nineteen hundred and
6 seventy-four and the effective date of this act shall receive such
7 salary as is provided by section six of chapter two hundred and
8 eighteen of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 5. Notwithstanding the provisions of section
2 sixteen of chapter five hundred and fifty-eight of the acts of
3 nineteen hundred and seventy-four, the justices of the municipal
4 court of the city of Boston who were appointed between the first
5 day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, and the
6 effective date of this act shall receive such salary as is provided by
7 section seventy-five of chapter two hundred and eighteen of the
8 General Laws, said salary to be effective as of the date of their
9 appointment.

1 SECTION 6. Notwithstanding the provisions of section
2 sixteen of chapter five hundred and fifty-eight of the acts of
3 nineteen hundred and seventy-four, any justice of a district court
4 who was appointed between the first day of January, nineteen
5 hundred and seventy-four, and the effective date of this act shall
6 receive such salary as is provided for the court to which he was
7 appointed by section seventy-seven A of section seventy-eight of
8 chapter two hundred and eighteen of the General Laws, said
9 salary to be effective as of the date of his appointment.

1 SECTION 7. Notwithstanding the provisions of section
2 sixteen of chapter five hundred and fifty-eight of the acts of
3 nineteen hundred and seventy-four, the recorders and deputy
4 recorders to whom the provisions of section fourteen of chapter
5 one hundred and eighty-five of the General Laws apply, the
6 registers and assistant registers to whom the provisions of section
7 thirty-five A and thirty-five B of chapter two hundred and
8 seventeen of the General Laws apply, and the clerks and assistant
9 clerks to whom the provisions of sections seventy-nine and eighty

10 of chapter two hundred and eighteen of the General Laws apply,
11 who were appointed between January first, nineteen hundred and
12 seventy-four, and the effective date of this act, shall receive such
13 salary as is provided in the respective said applicable sections,
14 said salary to be effective as of the date of their respective
15 appointments.

1 SECTION 8. Section four of this act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.

1 SECTION 9. Sections one, two, three, five, six and seven of
2 this act shall take effect as of July first, nineteen hundred and
3 seventy-five.
