RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING PUBLIC UTILITY CORRIDORS.

1 *Resolved*, That there is hereby established a special com-
2 mission consisting of the commissioner of natural resources,
3 the chairman of the department of public utilities and five
4 persons to be appointed by the governor to make an investiga-
5 tion and study of the feasibility, including cost, of establishing
6 public utility corridors on a long rang basis for joint use by
7 public utilities, considering not only the convenience of the
8 utilities but also the economic use of land, the effect on mu-
9 nicipalities and conservation values.
