AN ACT

Concerning the State Map.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 The secretary of the Commonwealth is hereby
2 authorized to secure the copy-right of such correc-
3 tions as may be added to the state map during the
4 year eighteen hundred and seventy, by Henry F.
5 Walling, the present superintendent of said map, and
6 to modify the existing contract with said Walling for
7 the publication of said map so as to include the term
8 of the new copy-right, and to remove the present
9 restrictions upon the price of said map, so far as the
10 same applies to its public sale.
