AN ACT REDEFINING "VIETNAM VETERAN."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause Forty-third of section 7 of chapter 4 of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out the eighth paragraph,
3 as amended by chapter 531 of the acts of 1968, and inserting
4 in place thereof the following: —

5 Vietnam veteran shall mean any veteran who has actively
6 performed such wartime service between February first, nine-
7 teen hundred and fifty-five and ending on a date to be deter-
8 mined by presidential proclamation and concurrent resolution
9 of the Congress of the United States.
