

HOUSE No. 4433

By Mr. Businger of Brookline, petition of John A. Businger for legislation to further regulate the administration of the Office of Campaign and Political Finance. Election Laws.

AN ACT FURTHER AFFECTING THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE OFFICE OF
CAMPAIGN AND POLITICAL FINANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of Chapter 55 of the General Laws as appearing in
2 the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking fifth
3 paragraph and inserting the following in place thereof: —

4 The director may appoint and remove such employees as the
5 work of the office may require. The director shall establish the
6 salaries, duties, and personnel regulations of all employees with
7 the office of campaign and political finance, as he deems necessary
8 to perform the duties of the office, provided, however, the salaries
9 of such employees shall not exceed the sum annually appropriated
10 by the general court. The provisions of sections nine A and forty-
11 five of chapter thirty, chapter thirty-one and chapter one hundred
12 and fifty E shall not apply to the employees of the office.
