

Chap. 212. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD TO BORROW MONEY FOR REMODELING, RECONSTRUCTING, MAKING EXTRAORDINARY REPAIRS TO, REEQUIPPING AND REFURNISHING THE SPRINGFIELD MUNICIPAL HOSPITAL.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of remodeling, reconstructing, making extraordinary repairs to, reequipping and refurnishing the Springfield Municipal Hospital, the city of Springfield may borrow from time to time, within a period of five years from the effective date of this act, such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, two million dollars, and may issue bonds or notes therefor, which shall bear on their face the words, Springfield Municipal Hospital Remodeling Loan, Act of 1974. Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan and such loans shall be paid in not more than twenty years from their dates. Indebtedness incurred under this act shall be in excess of the statutory limit, but shall, except as herein provided, be subject to chapter forty-four of the General Laws, exclusive of the limitations contained in the first paragraph of section seven thereof.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 213. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE SALE AND OPERATION OF SNOW VEHICLES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The third paragraph of section 24 of chapter 90B of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence, as appearing in chapter 62 of the acts of 1972, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:— No snow vehicle manufactured after July the first, nineteen hundred and seventy-five, shall be sold, offered for sale or operated that produces a sound pressure level of more than seventy-eight decibels.
