## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE SALE OF WOODSTOVES WITHOUT PROVIDING THEREWITH A LIST OF SAFETY PRECAUTIONS TO BE USED BY THE PURCHASER THEREOF.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 266 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 104A the following section:—
- 3 *Section 104B.* Whoever sells or offers for sale, at wholesale or
- 4 retail, a woodstove, without providing therewith a list of safety
- 5 precautions to be used by the purchaser thereof, shall punished by
- 6 a fine of not less than fifty nor more than two hundred dollars.
