Chapter 19. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF MASHPEE TO BORROW A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A WASTE TRANSFER STATION.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The town of Mashpee is hereby authorized to borrow an amount not to exceed two hundred and seventy-five thousand dollars under the provisions of clause (4A) of section seven of chapter forty-four of the General Laws for the construction of a solid waste transfer station in cooperation with the towns of Falmouth and Sandwich and the Massachusetts military reservation in said town of Sandwich, notwithstanding the location of said station in the town of Sandwich.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chapter 20. AN ACT TO PROVIDE INCREASED DISCLOSURE OF MORTGAGE INFORMATION AND TIMELY APPROVAL OF APPLICATIONS.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to immediately provide that the act providing for increased disclosure of mortgage information and timely approval of applications shall take effect on June first, nineteen hundred and eighty-eight, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.
