AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO CLEAR THE WEEDS AND OTHER GROWTH FROM WHITING'S POND IN THE TOWN OF NORTH ATTLEBOROUGH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The department of public health is hereby authorized and
- 2 directed to clear the weeds and other growth from Whiting's
- 3 pond in the town of North Attleborough. Said department
- 4 may employ such experts in the use of herbicides as it deems
- 5 necessary. Said department may expend for said purpose such
- 6 sums as may be appropriated therefor.
