AN ACT REQUIRING 100% FUNDING OF CHAPTER 70 REIMBURSEMENTS TO CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 70 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 11, as most recently amended by chap-
3 ter 261 of the acts of 1980, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following section: —

5 *Section 11.* The aid paid to any city, town regional school
6 district, or independent vocational school under this chapter
7 shall be equal to 100% of the amount of aid due to be paid
8 under this chapter to such city, town, regional school district
9 or independent vocational school. The school aid to be dis-
10 tributed under this chapter shall be subject to application.
